

Steps to FAFSA/CADAA Submission

CREATE AN FSA ID

Go to FSAID.ed.gov

The FSA ID serves as your legal, electronic signature for FAFSA The FSA ID replaces the FSA PIN. (Note: FSA ID not required for CA Dream Act Application (CADAA)

Note: Creating an FSA ID only takes a few minutes, but it can take a day or two to process, so it is best to do it ahead of time if you plan to attend a Cash for College workshop.

2 FILL OUT THE FAFSA/CADAA

Go to FAFSA.gov Go to dream.csac.ca.gov

APPLICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE STARTING OCTOBER 1. What you will need:

STUDENTS:

- Your student FSA ID to create the application
- Driver's license, if you have one
- Your Social Security card or number (Alien registration #, if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Student 2019 income & tax information (if applicable)
- List of colleges you are interested in attending

PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN:

- FSA ID for at least one parent/guardian (see step #1)
- Parent/Guardian Social Security card or number (Alien registration #, if not a U.S. citizen)
- Parent/Legal Guardian's 2019 income & tax information
- Any records of untaxed income such as child support payments, payments to/from retirement accounts, worker's compensation, etc.
